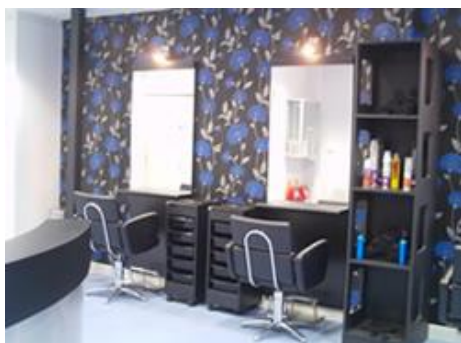


HAIR AND BEAUTY - City and Guilds Level 1

A member of Heathlands staff will attend with the students to provide communication support.

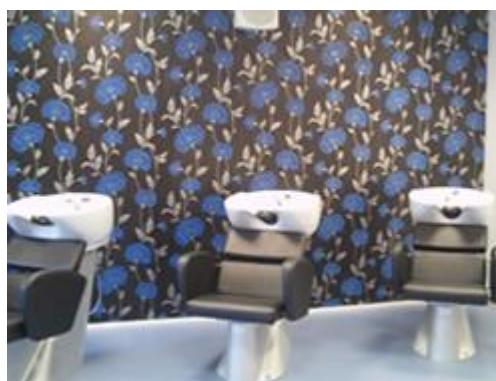
Students have experiences performing Hair & Beauty treatments on each other and clients, giving them a real working life experience.
