

## Heathlands Progress 2016

### Progress 8 performance at end of Key Stage 4 in 2016

Progress 8 is the new Key Stage 4 value added measure of progress of pupils across a selected set of 8 subjects. Pupils' results are compared to the actual achievements of other pupils with the same prior attainment at Key Stage 2.

**Heathlands was one of the top five highest performing special schools in England as shown on the current government website for comparing schools' progress.**

**Heathlands was one of only 8 special schools in England, of 408 schools in total, to achieve progress in the expected range.**


### Comparison with other schools for Deaf children

A Progress 8 score indicates whether pupils in the school made above or below average progress compared to pupils across England with similar end of KS2 results.

A score of zero or very close to zero means pupils do as well at key stage 4 as other pupils across England with similar end of KS2 results.

A score further below zero means pupils made even less progress.


**Heathlands achieved the second highest progress 8 score (0.12) compared to all other schools for Deaf children**

**Heathlands is one of only two schools for deaf children with KS4 progress comparable to pupils nationally with similar end of key stage 2 results.**


**Heathlands has the highest progress performance of schools for deaf children using sign language.**



**Heathlands achieves these positive results with much less money than most other schools for deaf children.**

Heathlands income per pupil = £24,238

Average income per pupil - other schools for deaf children using sign language = £34,538
