

KS4 - HUMANITIES Curriculum

Students study a range of units from the WJEC Entry Pathways syllabus obtaining credits to achieve an Award (8 or more credits), a Certificate (13 or more credits) or a Diploma (37 or more credits). Topics are chosen from both History and Geography to ensure that students get a broad curriculum in Key Stage 4. Students are also completing units for this course in their Religious Studies lessons and credits can be combined to ensure they achieve the highest certification possible.

All work is internally assessed throughout the two years with no external exams, and takes a wide range of forms: posters, presentations, group work, reports etc.
