

Land Based Studies at Oaklands College

This is an entry level course for students who are interested in learning skills related to a land-based job.

The award is offered at Entry Levels 2 and 3 and focuses on a variety of land-based vocational activities.

It will provide students with the basic practical skills and knowledge needed to either gain employment or progress to further training. It will also help develop common, social and interpersonal skills and widen life experiences.

No previous qualifications are required and the College provides support for those who have learning difficulties and disabilities.
