

How to lengthen blazer sleeves:

1. Turn the sleeve inside out.
2. Remove the link stitching in the lining to release the extra lining
3. Find the tack inside the sleeve head on each side that is just above the cuff – pull on this to break it on both sides
4. This will release the sleeve head down by 1.25 inches
5. Turn the sleeve inside out again to the correct side.
6. Pull it flat and with a damp cloth press in a new crease with an iron.
