







Parent Volunteers

We currently have vacancies for the following parent volunteers at Heathlands. This is a great opportunity to increase your skills, meet staff, students and have an insight into the running of the school day. Support and training will be given to all volunteers who will be subject to a DBS check before they start.

What	Why	When
Volunteer Gardener 	Lower School are looking for people who are keen to get involved with some gardening for the nursery. This would involve, for example, digging over the ground so the children can dig more easily and plant seeds.	Once a fortnight, flexible hours to be agreed with class teacher.
Volunteer Librarian 	Lower School need someone who loves to organise, enjoys cataloguing and is able to source books for topics for class teachers.	Hours to suit within the school working day.
Volunteer Reader for Lower School 	Lower School are looking for parents to help the children develop their reading skills. The ability to sign is essential in order to fully communicate with the children.	Reading is from 1pm-1.30pm each day.
Volunteer Readers for Upper School 	Upper School are looking for people who are willing to read with the children. We have a mix of both oral/BSL children and you would be paired appropriately.	Reading is between 1.10pm and 1.30pm each day.
