## Proposal to extend the age range of Heathlands School from September 2024


This Notice is given in accordance with section 19 (1) of the Education and Inspections Act 2006.

I hereby notify that Heathlands School are proposing to make an alteration to the school by extending the age range up to 18 from September 2024.

Heathlands is a community school for Deaf children, situated in Heathlands Drive, St Albans, AL3 5AY. As a specialist school for Deaf children the school serves a wide number of local authorities as well as the Deaf community within Hertfordshire. The proposal to extend the age range from 16 years to 18 years will enable the school to offer A levels and equivalent qualifications to students transitioning from Key Stage 4 to Key Stage 5. The Key Stage 5 offer will allow students to attend Heathlands on a daily basis to progress their learning.
